

OVERVIEW

The Cessna 150 is the introductory tricycle gear model in the Cessna lineup. In production ran from 1958 until 1975. In that short time period, the 150 became one of the most produced aircraft of all time, with nearly 24,000 airplanes rolling off the assembly line.

The 150 is purpose-built for flight training, casual cross-country, and VFR fun. With seating for two and a modest cargo area, it's an economical way to fly. Many pilots took their first lesson in a Cessna 150, building their skills on the aircraft's forgiving aerodynamics and straight-forward panel.

N22190 is an H-model variant of the Cessna 150, featuring slightly improved pilot legroom and electric flaps. It has two special features; and 2nd row bench seat and the Bush engine conversion STC improving engine power to 150hp.

The bench seat allows for carrying up to two additional passengers, subject to a total weight limit of 120 lbs. It's the perfect way to introduce children and young adults to the joys of aviation, all without having to move up in aircraft.


