The Bombardier Learjet 45 is a classic, mid-size jet first introduced in 1998.

Powered by Honeywell TFE731-20AR-1B engines, the Learjet 45 has a range of 1,423 nm with a cruise speed of 436 kts.

The Learjet is beloved for its ability to move passengers to their destination with speed, comfort, and efficiency. The 45 has a service ceiling of 51,000 feet, allowing for stunning views for crew and passengers on flights.

A crew of two pilots operate the aircraft safely with the help of a modern panel and advanced avionics. The Learjet 45 cabin features seating for 8 passengers and the ability to carry a payload of 1,500 lbs, including full fuel.

This Learjet 45 is a low-time, excellent example of what makes the Learjet 45 family so valued by its owners. Featuring an Executive cabin configuration, full galley and lav, and a modern Honeywell avionics suite, pilots and passengers will enjoy the flight.
