Thanks to RAM Series IV upgrades, the 414A punches above its weight. Performance increases yields a maximum range of 990 nm and a cruise speed of 215 ktas.

Featuring a pressurized cabin and seating for six, the engineers at Cessna outdid themselves with clever use of storage. Passenger baggage can be loaded in the aft cabin, wing & nose storage compartments.





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
